



Position yourself as a research leader of tomorrow

Canada is building world-class research capacity by recruiting top-tier postdoctoral researchers at an internationally competitive level of funding and positioning them for success as the research leaders of tomorrow. These prestigious two-year fellowships, worth \$70,000 per year, are open to both Canadian and International researchers who have recently completed a PhD, PhD-equivalent or health professional degree. Seventy fellowships will be awarded each year.

The **Banting Postdoctoral Fellowships Program** is unique in its emphasis on the synergy between applicants and research institutions. The University of Prince Edward Island has the opportunity to nominate an outstanding candidate in each of the Tri-Council areas. Under exceptional circumstances, the adjudication committee may nominate more than one applicant in a research area.

Applications related to health research will be received by CIHR, those related to natural sciences and/or engineering by NSERC, and social sciences and/or humanities by SSHRC. If you are unclear as to which area to select, please consult with the Faculty of Graduate Studies.
